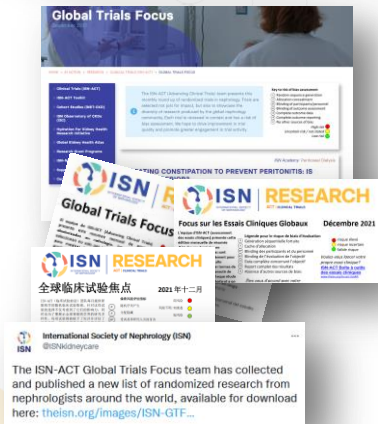

ISN Global Kidney Health Atlas (GKHA)



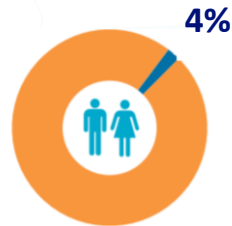
The ISN Global Kidney Health Atlas ([GKHA](#)) provides **comparative analyses and data synthesis** on **CKD** and its impact worldwide to:

- Build a global CKD care surveillance network.

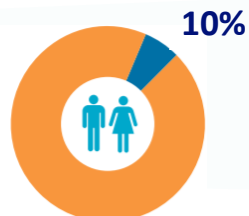
Goals

- To **understand, compare** and **monitor** how different countries around the world detect, treat, monitor, and advocate for people with kidney disease (**AKI** or **CKD**);
- **To compare** the availability, accessibility, and affordability of high-quality care for patients with kidney failure, and
- **To present** the results by country and region to enable comparison and data trends.

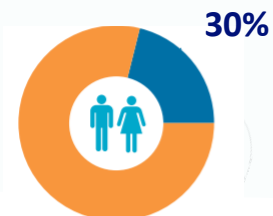

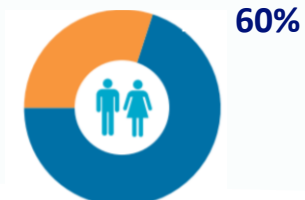
Low income Countries

Sharing Expertise to support the set-up of Renal Registries (SharE-RR)



- The ISN advocates integrated worldwide renal care. **Registries** play a vital role in defining disease burden, and monitoring treatment and outcomes, but vary in coverage & structure.

In **2017** the ISN established “**Sharing Expertise to support the set-up of Renal Registries**” ([SharE-RR](#)).

The **SharE-RR** team surveyed **91** organizations **worldwide** managing renal registries and evaluated their approaches toward collecting, managing, and reporting data on people with kidney diseases.

99% of registries covered adults receiving **hemodialysis** **92%** **peritoneal dialysis** & **74%** **transplant**.

- ➔ Over the next few years, the **SharE-RR** team will work to provide:
 - An open-access, global inventory of renal registries, including key facts on how they operate.
 - Useful advocacy tools and best practices for setting up renal registries.
 - Advice and hands-on guidance in setting up renal registries during workshops.

SHARing Expertise and the Renal Registries (SharE-RR) team supports the establishment and development of renal registries worldwide.

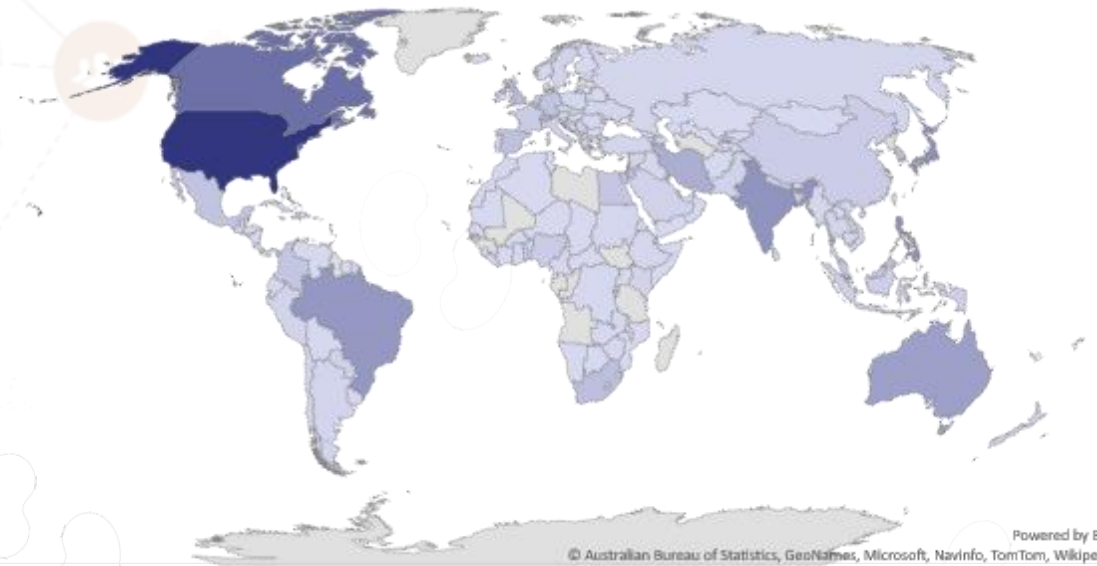
