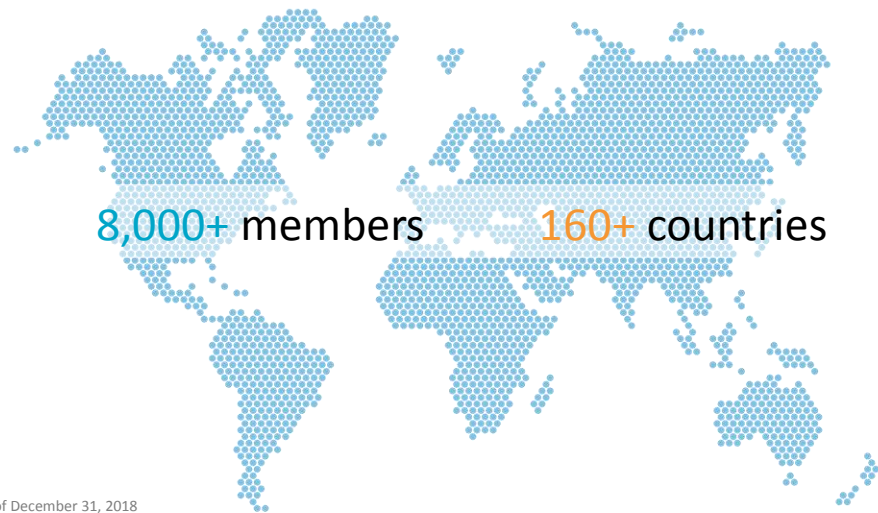

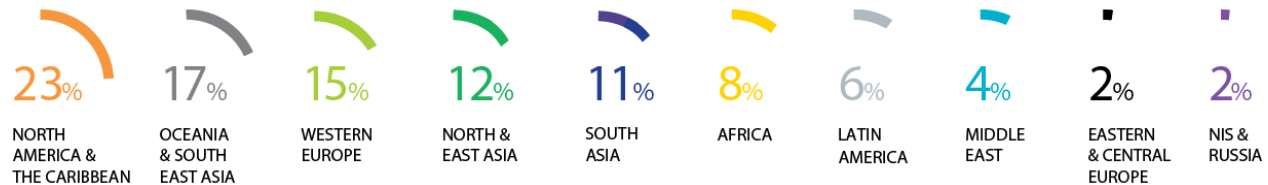

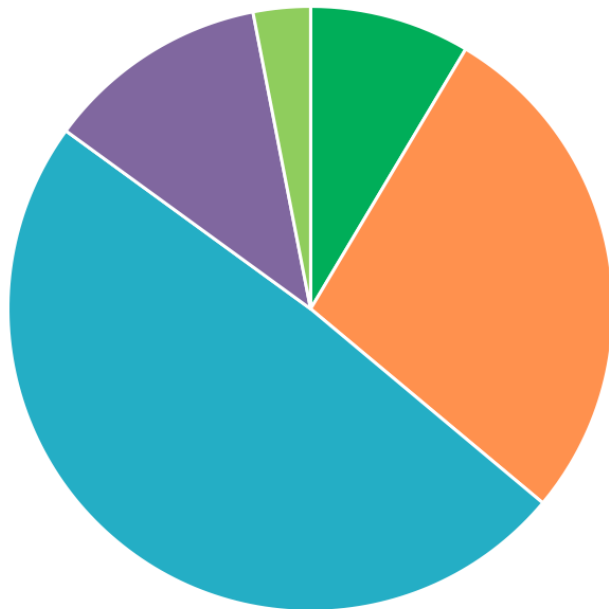

70 Sisters Centers pairs/trios are active in 2019

In total **36 centers** graduated since 2009

83 young physicians were awarded an ISN Fellowship grant in 2017
